

THE MILITARY SPOUSE JD NETWORK (“MSJDN”) PROCESS FOR AWARD NOMINATIONS BY THE ORGANIZATION

INTRODUCTION

MSJDN is a rich network of professionals, many of whom are making a tremendous impact on the world around them, whether in their professions, or in their communities. MSJDN, by virtue of its work, also often comes into contact with the same caliber of high-achieving individuals. Because many awards exist to honor the kinds of achievements garnered by MSJDN’s members, mentors, and partners, the organization developed this policy as a mechanism for making, and to provide members an avenue for seeking, official nominations for such award nominations from MSJDN.

WHO MAY NOMINATE

Request for an official nomination from MSJDN must be sought in writing by an MSJDN member. Such written requests may be submitted to the Award Selection Committee for consideration at any time, but preferable at least ninety days before the deadline for any award nomination. Current members of the Awards Selection Committee are excluded as nominators and/or as candidates for any award under their purview. Any exceptions are stated under the applicable award.

ELIGIBILITY

Membership in MSJDN is not an eligibility requirement for a nomination by MSJDN to be made. However, work for MSJDN, or work that benefits MSJDN or its members, will be considered as part of any request for nomination.

HOW TO NOMINATE

All requests for MSJDN nominations for individuals or organizations must include:

1. A nomination justification statement;
2. A link to the award or honor where the nomination will be submitted;
3. Clear guidance regarding nomination instructions;
4. A deadline for nomination submission; and
5. A curriculum vitae as well as evidence of accomplishments.

As some awards have specific nomination requirements, please provide that information if available. Nominations should not include voluminous materials. Clear, concise statements of achievements are of more value. Information from public sources with referenced links is welcomed. Please send nominations to awards@msjdn.org.

NOMINATION APPROVAL

MSJDN’s Awards Selection Committee, or where a Committee does not currently exist then the Board, will consider all documentation submitted, the nature of the award and the award’s purpose, and relevance to MSJDN’s work and mission. The Awards Selection Committee will then propose nominations to the Board for final vote and approval.
